Is power back in Brazil after a blackout?

RIO DE JANEIRO (AP) -- Power was back in most of Brazil on Tuesday afternoon, after a major blackout left much of the north and northeast regions without any electricity for nearly six hours, the country's energy ministry said.

How do you deal with a power outage in Brazil?

Park vehicles in secure areas. Confirm business appointments. Verify that security systems are working. Ensure that generators are functional and refuel devices when necessary. Power outages affect at least 15 states in Brazil as of early Aug. 15. Transport and business disruptions likely in affected areas.

What happened in Brazil during a power outage?

At least 19 of Brazil's states and the capital city of Brasilia were affected by the outage, according to the online news site G1. The outage also affected public transportation. Passengers had to evacuate subway lines in major cities, including Sao Paulo, Belo Horizonte and Salvador. Traffic lights were out in other cities.

How many states are affected by power outages in Brazil?

Power outages affect at least 15 states in Brazil as of early Aug. 15. Transport and business disruptions likely in affected areas. Power outages affected several parts of the country from approximately 08:20 Aug. 15.

Is Brazilian power back online?

SAO PAULO, Aug 15 (Reuters) - Power was fully back online for most Brazilian residents on Tuesday afternoon after an "incident" caused outages across the nation.

Which companies are affected by the power outages in Brazil?

Private power firms operating in Brazil were affected by the outages. Equatorial Energia (EQTL3.SA) and Enel Brasil had said earlier in the day they were resuming power supply to their clients, while CPFL Energia (CPFE3.SA) said supply had already resumed for all customers.

Transport and business disruptions are likely in affected areas; businesses without backup generators could temporarily suspend operations. Mobile voice and internet service disruptions are possible. The electricity disruptions could also affect ATMs and fueling stations.

A major-scale power outage left all of Brazil's states but one in the dark on Tuesday morning while the causes for such an event are still under investigation, it was reported.

Brazil's national grid operator ONS confirmed Thursday in a preliminary analysis report that the failure of the Quixadá-Itaipava II transmission line, operated by Eletrobras' subsidiary Chesf, caused a technical effect that split the country into three electrical areas during the power outage occurred on Tuesday.

The series of large-scale power outages in 2024 left millions of Brazilians without electricity and resulted in massive financial losses, highlighting the vulnerabilities of the country's power grid, which is ill-prepared for both climate catastrophes and minor incidents.
