

How much power does Cameroon have?

The total dependent installed capacity of Cameroon as of July 2019 is 1541.39 MW[21,25]. This composed of: hydropower (61%),natural gas (20%),oil (18%) and renewable energy sources (1%). The state-run utility ENEO owns 65%,which are made up of thirteen grid-connected and twenty-four remote thermal plants.

The Cameroon LEAP model The bottom-up modelling methodology was used to developed the Cameroon power generation model in LEAP. The base year choice of 2016 was chosen due to the availability of reliable data, and commencement of most energy sector plans.

On the former,the nation aims to exploit its abundancehydropower potential. Activities towards both targets have already commenced. Cameroon also plans grid interconnection with other countries in line with creating the Central African Power Pool (CAPP) [33]. However,only national demand and capacity are considered in this study.

This projected 5.9 GWcapacity savings is more than the total anticipated hydropower capacity in the Energy Sector Development Project (PDSEN) of the Cameroon's Ministry of Energy and Water Resources [5].

Substantial economic savings from avoided investment, O&M, fuel costs from new power plants. Increased energy security for Cameroon from the reduced importation of fossil fuels for new thermal plants.

Recommended actions for minimizing power losses in Cameroon entails conducting appropriate power system studies to determine/select the optimal size, location and specifications of grid components (such as transformers, transmission and distribution lines, capacitor banks and compensators).
