Why are Zambia's power cuts so bad?

The power cuts have come as a shock to the 43% of Zambians who are connected to the grid and have taken electricity for granted all their lives. But one of the severest droughts in decades - caused by the El Niño weather phenomenon - has decimated Zambia's power-generation capacity.
