How many companies are in RE100?

As of January 2016, the RE100 campaign has over 50 companies on board - compared to 15 in January 2015. The companies in RE100 have different target years for reaching 100% renewable electricity. Many have set interim targets to help keep themselves on track.

How many RE100 companies are going '100% renewable'?

Over 400 RE100 companies have made a commitment to go '100% renewable'. These members have increased their ambition, bringing forward their target dates for 100% renewable electricity.

Are RE100 members committed to renewable electricity?

RE100 members commit to renewable electricity in their own operations, but a chain reaction is expected as the RE100 members have started to push their ambitions further, raising the bar for their suppliers by encouraging them to set the same ambitious renewable targets.

Who can join the RE100 initiative?

Businesses all over the world can join the RE100 initiative organised by The Climate Group and CDP. RE100 companies make a commitment to go '100% renewable' and set a public goal to procure 100% of their electricity from renewable sources by a specified year, but their strategies vary in how they plan to reach their targets.

What is RE100?

RE100 is a global initiative organised by The Climate Group and CDP that comprises more than 400 influential corporates committed to 100% renewable electricity. Together, members drive climate action on clean power, electric transport, and smarter energy use in more than 175 markets worldwide.

What are the RE100 Leadership Awards?

The RE100 Leadership Awards recognise the climate leadership of our members and their work accelerating the global transition to 100% renewable electricity. Over 400 RE100 companies have made a commitment to go '100% renewable'.

RE100 is a global initiative of over 300 influential corporates committed to 100% renewable electricity. Businesses all over the world can join the RE100 initiative organised by The Climate Group and CDP.

The RE100 requires member companies to openly commit to using 100% renewable electricity across all its local and global operations, latest by 2050. Annually, RE100 publicly reports a list of its active members and each of ...

Companies joining RE100 help to set a public goal to source 100% of their global electricity consumption from renewable sources by a specified target year. They disclose their electricity data annually, and the RE100 report on their progress.

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Standard & Poor's Global published its 2021 sustainability index, which included 631 companies from around the world, including 14 Colombian companies that stand out for their commitment in this area.

In 2019, CHANEL achieved 41% renewable electricity for its owned and operated facilities globally. In 2020, the company joined RE100 with a commitment to achieve 100% renewable electricity by 2025, with an interim target of 97% by 2021.

RE100 published a technical briefing, showing companies how to accurately describe their usage and procurement of renewable electricity. As more global companies commit to using renewable electricity in their own operations, a chain reaction is expected where suppliers around the world also set the ambitious renewable targets.

The shift that is currently underway can be accelerated if more companies use their purchasing power to procure and generate electricity from renewable sources. This is the focus of the RE100 campaign, led by The ...

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
