

4 · EKOenergy's Climate Fund is currently seeking to fund 15-20 short-term solar PV and wind energy projects taking place in low- and middle-income countries. Projects must be community-prioritised initiatives coordinated by non-profit NGOs and implemented in cooperation with enterprises, authorities, and other relevant stakeholders.

To encourage and accelerate the energy transition, the Flemish government has launched several energy subsidies. These subsidies are designed to help companies finance their green and energy-efficient investments.

Community solar solution to energise poor households. Access to affordable renewable energy is important in Europe's green transition and meeting the Paris Climate Agreement goals. While the share of renewable energy has more than doubled between 2004 and 2019, not all households are able to afford renewable energy systems.

On 9 November 2023, the Belgian federal public service for the economy ("FPS Economy") launched the 2023 call for projects under the Energy Transition Fund (ETF) (Dutch I French). The ETF aims to encourage innovative research and development projects in Belgium's energy sector.

Vlaams Energie- en Klimaatagentschap (VEKA), the energy agency of the Belgian region of Flanders, has launched the first call of this year to apply for solar rebates - the so-called "solar PV...

The Flemish region will open the third Green Power call for proposals on 1 December, to promote energy-saving projects. With a budget of 5 million euros, the call will have two subcalls: EUR500,000 is earmarked for projects "Solar panels" with an investment capacity of more than 40 kW up to and including 2 MW, placed on marginal land and ...

The Belgian government is committed to the energy transition with its 2030 global investment plan, which foresees the construction and maintenance of solar panels with a total capacity equal to that of the existing nuclear power plants. Solar panels are good for the environment and reduce CO2 emissions.

The EIB Group signed nearly EUR2.4 billion in financing for 26 projects in Belgium in 2023, as part of global funding totalling EUR88 billion for over 900 high-impact projects. A record EUR49 billion (55.8%) of the Group's investments in 2023 were green; in Belgium financing for climate action and environmental sustainability even hit 79%.
