Why should the Gambia invest in solar energy?

To match the rising demand and to provide sustainable and accessible energy to all Gambians, the potential for solar energy investment is immense in The Gambia. The government of The Gambia seeks to increase RE's contribution to 40% from 2% presently in the coming years.

How much solar power does Gambia have in 2022?

According to the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA), Gambia only had 2 MW of installed PV capacity at the end of 2022. Gambian utility Nawec recently started building a 23 MW solar project in Jambur, in Gambia's West Coast Region.

How will 'solarisation' transform the electricity sector of the Gambia?

The project will transform the electricity sector of The Gambia via through the 'Solarisation' of up to 1000 schools and 100 health facilities especially the remote areas of the country. Furthermore it will provide beneficiaries in the education and health sectors with reliable and clean energy thereby reducing our carbon footprint.

What is the energy access rate in Gambia?

How can the Gambia benefit from a reliable energy supply?

More than 1,000 schools and 100 health centres in rural parts of the Gambia that currently have limited electricity access are expected benefit from reliable energy supply through new connections to the national energy network and provision of off-grid solar and battery systems.

Gambia's Ministry of Petroleum and Energy (MoPE) and state-owned utility Nawec have jointly launched a tender for the construction of a 50 MW PV plant in Soma, south of the River Gambia.

"The project to provide renewable energy to The Gambia will not only supply Basse and Farafenni with sustainable electricity. It will also replace the electricity produced by heavy fuel oil with solar energy.
