Will Mauritania get a big green energy project?

Image by GreenGo Energy () Danish renewable energy developer GreenGo Energy Group on Monday unveiled plans for a huge green energy project in Mauritania that will involve 60 GW/190 TWh of hybrid solar and wind generation and 35 GW of electrolysis capacity.

How many solar panels does Mauritania produce a year?

The facility is responsible for 10% of Mauritania's grid capacity. It generates 25,409 megawatt-hours of renewable electricity per year and displaces approximately 21,225 tons of CO₂. The plant's almost 30,000 solar panels, manufactured by Masdar PV, provide electricity to more than 10,000 houses in Nouakchott.

Does Mauritania have solar?

TOUJOUNINE - Solar Averaging seven days of rain a year, Mauritania's climate is ideal for solar and the country's first major development in the sector did not disappoint in this regard with 54,000 panels supporting 50 MW production capacity at Toujounine, on the northern outskirts of the nation's capital.

Who owns Mauritania's electricity plant?

Completed in 2017, the \$53 million plant is run by the national electricity company, Sociéte Mauritanienne d'Electricité (Somelec), and has seen ongoing works since its inauguration by (then) President Mohamed Ould Abdel Aziz, removing an estimated 57,000 tonnes of CO₂ per annum and supplying 10% of Mauritania's net energy production.
