Does Moldova have a good energy sector?

Moldova is also on the right path to developing a sound institutional structure in the energy sector, informed by better statistical data. The National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) is commended for its efforts to improve energy data collection and reporting.

Why did Moldova impose a state of emergency?

C HISINAU, Moldova (AP) -- Moldova's parliament on Friday voted in favor of imposing a state of emergency in the energy sector over fears that Russia could leave the European Union candidate country without sufficient natural gas supplies this winter.

What are the sources of electricity and gas imports in Moldova?

The sources of electricity and gas imports are not diversified and crucially depend on gas supply from Russia and electricity supply from the Moldavskaya GRES power station, which operates beyond the control of the Moldovan government.

What is Moldova's long-term goal in the electricity sector?

In the electricity sector, Moldova's long-term objective was to fully interconnect with the European Network of Transmission System Operators for Electricity (ENTSO-E). This was achieved significantly earlier than planned, due to Russia's invasion of Ukraine in late February 2022.

How does Moldova get natural gas?

However, Moldova still procures natural gas almost exclusively from Gazprom through the traditional route from Ukraine: the Iasi-Ungheni-Chisinau pipeline remains mostly idle, and the Trans-Balkan reverse flow has not yet resulted in any significant flow to Moldova.

Does Moldova have a competitive gas market?

Regarding the gas sector reforms, Moldova has adopted several regulations, including the network code and market rules, as a step towards the establishment of a competitive gas market.

In 2022, Moldova experienced one of its worst energy crises because of the Russian invasion of Ukraine. Through international cooperation, Moldova seeks to implement its energy strategy by 2030 for energy independence, security, structural modernization, and diversification.

Moldova needs to import most energy commodities to meet the domestic demand. All natural gas consumption (2.1 Mtoe, or 2.9 billion cubic metres (bcm) in 2018) is met through imports, mainly from Russia.

Moldova's energy self-sufficiency is among the lowest in the world: only around 25% of its energy demand is covered by domestic production, consisting almost entirely of solid biomass and variable renewable energy sources. Moldova imports 100% of its gas and coal consumption, nearly all of its oil consumption and around 80% of its electricity ...

Moldova's energy sector relies heavily on imports of electricity and gas. The country produces only about 20 percent of its annual electricity consumption from natural gas-fired combined heat and electricity power plants. Moldova has one hydropower plant, the Costesti Hydropower Plant. Moldavskaya GRES (MGRES) in the separatist region of ...
