What is Cecca & how does it work?

CECCA is built around key pillars of implementation: power system operations and regulatory frameworks for increasing VRE shares; country and regional power system planning with renewables; zoning and renewable resource assessment; and capacity building and information dissemination.

What is a CEC and how does it work?

The CEC is composed of a Council, Secretariat, and Joint Public Advisory Committee (JPAC). The Council is composed of Cabinet-level environmental officials from each of the ECA parties. It governs the CEC, defines strategic priorities for collaborative work, and approves the overall program and budget.

How has the current crisis impacted EU projects in Nicaragua?

The current crisis aside, centralised decision making and weak institutional capacity, coupled with strong scepticism on the part of the government to work with certain external actors has typically complicated the implementation of EU projects in Nicaragua.

When did the CEC start?

The CEC concept was conceived by Johns Hopkins University Applied Physics Laboratory in the early 1970s. The concept was originally called Battle Group Anti-Air Warfare (AAW) Coordination. The first critical at-sea experiment with a system prototype occurred in 1990. The CEC became a Navy acquisition program in 1992.

Is Panama a Cecca member?

In 2016, when only Nicaragua and Panama were IRENA Members among CECCA countries, Panama was chosen as the pilot country of the initiative. As such, CECCA activities began advancing in conjunction with the Panama Renewables Readiness Assessment (RRA).
