Why is Central African Republic investing in electricity?

With an electrification rate of 35% in Bangui, 8% in the main provincial cities and towns, and only 2% in rural communes, the Central African Republic has invested in the energy sector as an engine of development to increase access to electricity and promote sustainable growth.

How much solar power does Africa have?

Currently, the deployment of solar PV and wind power in Africa is roughly evenly matched, with installed capacities of solar PV at around 8 GW as of 2020-21 12, and wind power at 6.5 GW 13. For solar power, this number is strongly dominated by South Africa and Egypt, which cover around 80% of installed capacity on the continent 12.

What can solar power do for Africa?

Solar power has vast potential to support commercial and industrial activities in Africa, including water pumping, milling, cooling, and the storage of food and medical supplies. A wider penetration of solar power in many parts of Africa can help automate these processes.
