How many solar PV farms will Guyana have?

Guyana Power and Light Inc. (GPL) is preparing plans for three utility-scale solar PV farms totaling 30 MW for the national grid in the long term, as well as a 0.75 MW Solar PV Farm at Wakenaam and a 4 MW Solar PV Farm at Onverwagt in the near future.

How much solar energy is available in Guyana?

As of 2018, the total installed capacity for Solar PV in Guyana is 4.63 MW, with an estimated annual generation of 7.16 GWh. Solar energy is used for several purposes in Guyana, including drying agricultural produce, irrigation, ICT, and to improve electricity access in rural areas.

Is Guyana a good place to install solar PV?

Most locations across Guyana have excellent solar insolation levels and are ideal for solar PV generation. As of 2018, the total installed capacity for Solar PV in Guyana is 4.63 MW, with an estimated annual generation of 7.16 GWh.

What is the main source of energy in Guyana?

Currently, imported petroleum-based fuels are the main source of energy in Guyana.

By 2026, the GUY SOL initiative will install 33 MWp of solar photovoltaic (PV) systems nationwide, supported by a US\$83.3 million investment. This includes additional social programs aimed at benefiting local communities across Guyana. ---

The solar farms are expected to produce 35 megawatts of solar power with the first 18 megawatts to become available by January 2026. The Government through Guyana Power and Light Inc. (GPL) has already acquired the land in the respective regions. The solar farms will be constructed by Chinese state-owned conglomerate SUMEC Co Ltd.

The solar farm will directly benefit two key areas: Onderneeming, which will receive five MWp of solar energy backed by 7.5 MWp of battery storage, and Charity, which will benefit from three MWp of solar energy supported by 4.5 MWp of battery storage.

Peak demand for electricity in Guyana stands at about 153 megawatts (MW) currently. In coming years, however, that demand is expected to triple. One major upcoming solar project, Dr. Sharma said, is the construction ...
