Is Tuvalu still a Pacific island nation?

Tuvalu, a Pacific island nation on the frontline of the climate crisis, is fighting to retain its land--and its identity. Is Tuvalu under threat?

Today, October 1, marks Tuvalu Independence Day -- the date that, in 1978, the island became an independent sovereign state. However, it's now a nation under threat. Tuvalu is on the front lines of the climate crisis, with regular flooding already destroying vital crops and infrastructure.

Is Tuvalu a member of the Pacific Community?

Tuvalu participates in the work of the Pacific Community (SPC) and is a member of the Pacific Islands Forum, the Commonwealth of Nations and the United Nations. It has maintained a mission at the United Nations in New York City since 2000.

Are king tides coming to Tuvalu?

King tides are not new to Tuvaluans, but recent flooding had some questioning how much time they had left in their home country. This year, it was estimated that 20 per cent of Tuvalu's population applied for the Pacific Engagement Visa, a pathway for Pacific islanders to gain permanent residency in Australia.

What is the title of the king of Tuvalu?

Since the accession of King Charles III, the monarch's title is: Charles the Third, by the Grace of God King of Tuvalu and of His other Realms and Territories, Head of the Commonwealth.

When is the King's birthday in Tuvalu?

The King's Official Birthday is a public holiday in Tuvalu. It is usually celebrated on the second Saturday of June every year. Tuvaluans celebrate it with church services and prayers, singing God Save The King and Tuvalu mo te Atua, flag hoisting, public speeches, a royal salute, and a parade.

Kingia is a genus consisting of a single species, *Kingia australis*, and belongs to the plant family Dasygongonaceae. The Aboriginal name bullanock is used as a common name for the plant. It has a thick pseudo-trunk consisting of accumulated leaf-bases, with a cluster of long, slender leaves on top. The trunk is usually unbranched, but can branch if the growing tip is damaged.

*Kingia australis* also commonly grows in the same habitats. It is mostly solitary, typically 1-2 m in height, however multi-stemmed specimens can occur as well as isolated populations reaching in excess of 6 m (Figs. 27 & 28). Kingia has a few short pom-pom-like flower clusters rising not far above the leaves and is not botanically close to Xanthorrhoea. The favoured common name is simply Kingia or Bullanock (and never Black Gin which is quite sensibly, along with Black Boy for Xanthorrhoea, considered in appropriate and offensive today).
