A new solar panel roof has been inaugurated at the Vatican to provide renewable energy to the museum. It's part of Pope Francis' plans to ensure the city state in Rome runs entirely on green energy. Italian energy supplier ACEA installed the photovoltaic roof in just six months in the Courtyard of the Corazze entrance.

How long did it take ACEA to install a photovoltaic roof?

Italian energy supplier ACEA installed the photovoltaic roof in just six months in the Courtyard of the Corazze entrance. "The most difficult thing is to integrate and find spaces to build photovoltaic infrastructure in places that are already heavily built up," said ACEA president, Barbara Marinali.
